



 Exports from Vermont helped contribute to the \$2.21 trillion of U.S. goods and services exports in 2016.



Vermont goods exports in 2016


Vermont's Top 5 Export Categories (Millions of U.S. Dollars)



Exports Support Jobs

 Nationally, U.S. jobs supported by exports reached an estimated 11.5 million in 2015, up 1.9 million from 2009.

Exports Sustain Thousands of Vermont Businesses



...and **18%** of known Vermont goods export value





Vermont Employment in Foreign-Owned Companies Number of Employees by Country of UBO






Free Trade Agreements

- The U.S. currently has 14 free trade agreements in force with 20 countries.
- Vermont's exports to U.S. FTA partners totaled \$1.6 billion in 2016.

In 2016, exports to FTA markets accounted for **52%** of Vermont exports
